HOW THE RETREAT WORKS

HOUSING: The first 75 people to register will stay in the Inn (4 to a room). The rest stay in Burgess Hall. Be sure to list a roommate preference on registration form.

Friday Night: Registration is 6 pm—8pm. After some preliminary fun, we start with a great worship band and an exciting speaker. The retreat starts at 8 pm, so eat dinner before you come or on your way to Windsor Hills Retreat Center.

Saturday: We eat breakfast followed by a morning service. After that the fun will proceed until lunchtime, when we will break for food. There will be some discussion groups meeting after lunch covering some different topics, but by 2 pm, the agenda will be fun and games for the rest of the day.

Activity choices—everything from indoor sports and games to outdoor craziness. We plan to carve out an ice rink for winter boot hockey. By dividing the retreat group into four or five different components, there will be plenty of fun for everyone. Bring your tubes, snowshoes, lots of gloves, as well as sneakers and whatever you need for volleyball, basketball, etc.

Sunday: After breakfast, we'll clean up and then have a worship service. The retreat ends after lunch on Sunday (1 pm)
