Hey, Teens! You will want to **bring** (at least!) the following items with you to camp:

- ❖ Bedroll/ Sleeping bag and pillow, towel, dirty clothes bag.
- ❖ Sneakers (open-toed shoes are prohibited in the kitchen.), swimming suit/sandals.
- ❖ Flashlight, **bug spray**, sun screen, warm AND cool clothes, your Bible, a sense of humor.
- ❖ Appropriate cleaning products for your body, an alarm clock (battery is best), a little cash for snacks.

You will get a \$2 daily allowance at the snack shack.

You also receive a \$50 scholarship for your camping program this summer for completing the week.

(no cash value, good this year only)

We are excited that you want to be a part of the Windsor Hills Team this year. Our mission is to create an atmosphere where: a) Campers and staff can have a great experience and b) God can work in the hearts and lives of us all. For this to happen, we need you to observe the following rules. If we all pull together, everyone will have a fantastic time.

Please **leave at home**: valuables, expensive jewelry / clothes, electronic equipment , cell phones & instruments; water balloons, shaving cream not intended for shaving, expensive cameras.

Camp Rules for All Teen Workers

1. Christian conduct is expected of all workers. This means modest apparel and respectful communication (no swearing, whining or rudeness) Pornography is prohibited, as are alcoholic beverages, tobacco, illegal drugs, and weapons of any kind.
2. Be on time for all scheduled work periods, activities and meals.
3. Laundry must be done in the bath house laundry during your free time. It may not be done in the kitchen.
4. Conduct yourself in a Christian manner at all times. Be respectful to everyone. (sounds like number one again, doesn't it?)
5. Cabins are to be kept clean at all times. A daily inspection might take place.
6. For safety, do not sit on the tailgate or sides of any truck. No standing in truck beds while in motion.
7. No one is allowed in staff housing unless they are assigned there. Do not go anywhere near any cabin where members of the opposite sex are housed. (No Visitors)
8. No waterfront use without a lifeguard. No one on the waterfront after 8:30 PM
9. No TVs, VCRs, radios, CD/DVD players, Ipods, MP3 players or other media are allowed in cabins. Don't bring them!
10. Be in your assigned cabin with lights out at announced curfew. (somewhere between 10 and 11 PM)
11. No one under the age of 18 is allowed off the grounds unless the Exec. Director drives them or assigns a driver 21 or older.
12. No visitors on grounds without the express permission of the Executive Director
13. Do not borrow anything from anyone without their permission (this is stealing)
14. No Non-WHC Paid Summer Staff or Adult (21 or older) Volunteer Staff drives camp vehicles (on or off the grounds). All drivers must be licensed and approved by the Executive Director.
15. We expect you to cooperate with your supervisors and chaplains, displaying a good attitude while you do so.
16. No one stays on the grounds over the weekend without advance preparation and permission from the Executive Director

Infractions of rules dealing with controlled substances, waterfront and vehicle safety, respect of privacy, and cooperation with supervisors are very serious. You should expect to be sent home if you break these rules.

Please be aware that if you break the laws of the State of NH, there may be serious legal consequences.

Please understand that when you join the staff of WHC you become a part of the hospitality team of the camp. Your conduct reflects on our image. **We exist to serve Christ by serving others.** That means when you are a **worker**, your program will be separate from the other campers who are on the facility at the same time. You will have your own devotional times, your own program times, your own swimming times. Pranks are not an acceptable part of the program, because they frequently intrude on our ability to serve others.
