Youth Chaplain

Duties will include:

1. Serving as an overnight counselor for same gender staff, housing in the staff dorm.
2. Serving as leader for youth activities/ devotional activities in rotation with other chaplains and staff members.
3. Actively participating in training sessions for youth ministry events.
4. Developing a personal knowledge of the teens within your responsibility area.
5. Serving as a member of the transition team between camps. On transition days, all staff work together to restore the camp to operating condition before the next group arrives. This will mean cabin cleaning, running errands (Valid driver's license desirable!) and whatever else is deemed necessary by the program director.
6. Running errands; valid driver's license desirable.
7. Supervising youth workers
8. Assisting permanent staff in any way necessary (may include helping in the dining hall/kitchen/office)

The waking hours of most days are divided into thirds – morning to noon, noon to dinner, dinner to lights out. Chaplains will work one period with the teens they supervise. A second period will be open to allow for preparation time, reading/study, or interaction with kids. The third period will be spent in doing ministry with the teens. These are rough estimates, and actual responsibilities vary greatly from week to week.

This year we will ask our chaplains to instruct us how to use technology to assist us in the spiritual development of our teen workers.

Duration: Mon., June 16, 2008, 10 AM through Sat., August 16, 2008, 5:00 PM

We will provide:

- Room and board
- \$2.00 credit at Snack Shack each day worked (no cash)
- Use of all facilities
- A day and a half off each week (Saturday morning through Sunday afternoon, or Saturday afternoon through Monday morning)
- Salary (gross) in the amount of \$2,500
